

COVID-19 Management of Non-Hospitalized Confirmed Case and Their Contacts Flowsheet

Regional Communicable Disease Control Team (Team Lead)

Receive notification of confirmed case who resides in a First Nation community by fastest means possible (FMP) through:

- Lab report
- Alberta Health Services (AHS) CDC/Zone MOH/Zone MOH designate
- First Nations Inuit Health Branch (FNIHB)-MOH

- Confirm the diagnosis and that individual meets case definition.
 - Person with provincial laboratory confirmation of infection with the virus that causes COVID-19
- Notify MOH if not already aware

On the lab report, check the following:

- Does it appear that the client lives in a FN community? Which community? Is there any contact information for the client?
- What is the client's age? (Note parent/guardian contact information if the client is a child)
- Who is the ordering physician?

Review Netcare to obtain any additional background information:

- History of hospitalization, intensive care unit admission, isolation, mechanical ventilation, date of admission.
- Laboratory Information (microbiology, virology, serology)
- Identify clinical evaluations, complications and diagnoses/comorbidities.
- Review related diagnostic imaging and consult reports.

Enter the case into the SIA Data Base using the lab report

Assign the case to Regional COVID-19 Case Management and Contact Tracing team member.

Case Notification:

- Notify them of the diagnosis of COVID-19
- Confirm they are medically stable to be at home
- Notify of isolation order for cases
- Notify of isolation order for close contacts
- Inform them that the Community Health Nurse will be following up (if not done by community health nurse)

<p>Receive and Review the AH COVID-19 Reporting Form from the CHN and forward it to Team Lead</p> <p>Update the information on the SIA Data Base (team lead)</p> <p>Forward the AH COVID-19 Reporting Form to Alberta Health (team lead)</p>	<p>Contact the confirmed case 10 days after symptom onset. If symptoms have resolved discontinue Isolation.</p> <p>If symptoms persist, extend isolation until symptoms are resolved. Have case contact CHN when symptoms resolve to discontinue isolation. Contact the case at 14 days if they have not contact you.</p> <p>Notify Regional CDC Team if symptoms have not resolved after 14 days or if client is hospitalized at any point</p>
<p>Proceed to COVID-19 Management of Close Contacts of Confirmed and Probable Cases Flowsheet</p>	<p>Follow up close contacts according to the MOH directions provided on the COVID-19 Contact List</p>
