

## **Acceptable Swab Types for COVID Testing**

Due to shortages of standard collection kits, available swabs and collection containers vary at patient testing locations. **Do not use swab types other than those indicated below.** No other swab types are acceptable for COVID-19 or other respiratory virus testing at this time. Other acceptable specimen types for COVID-19 and other respiratory virus testing include: nasopharyngeal aspirate, endotracheal aspirate, bronchoalveolar lavage (BAL).
